Camp Charles - Rowboat Rentals Information and Rental Agreement

Rowboats are now available for units to rent on a weekend basis at Camp Charles. This opportunity is available to all Scouting units including Cub Scout Packs, Troops, Venturing Crews and Sea Scout Ships.

Cub Scout Packs: Camp Charles is currently the only Council property suitable for boating activities for Cub Scout age youth.

HOW TO MAKE RESERVATIONS: Any unit wishing to reserve the row boats should review the Boating Safety and complete the reservation form and submit to the Council Office with all fees. (Rental Equipment requires all fees to be paid before reservations will be honored.) The adult leader should also sign and submit the Properties Use Procedures Form and submit with the reservation form.

- All users are expected to follow the principles outlined for Safety Afloat in the Guide to Safe Scouting.
- 1. Adult Leaders supervising activities afloat must have completed Safety Afloat training within the previous two years
- 2. Rowboat rentals must be supervised by a mature and conscientious adult age 21 or older.
- 3. For Cub Scouts: the leadership ratio is one trained (safety afloat) adult per 10 participants.
- 4. For Boy Scouts/Venturers: the leadership ratio is one trained (safety afloat) adult leader per 10 participants.
- 5. A complete heath history is required for all participants.
- 6. All participants must complete a BSA swimmer classification test to operate a row boat.
- 7. All boaters must wear a properly fitted US Coast Guard approved life jacket.
- 8. All boaters are paired with a buddy who is with them in the row boat.
- The Unit is financially responsible for replacing any lost or damaged equipment.
