

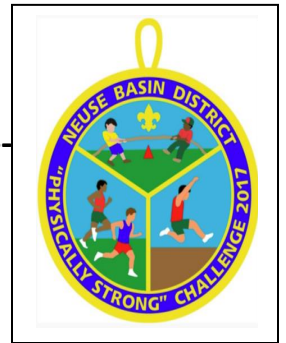

GENERAL RULES!

- Challenge Registration is due by March 1, 2018! Sign up immediately! Schedules must be made and supplies must be ordered!
- Unit flags should be brought to the Opening Ceremony. All Scouts, Scouters, & Designated Representative should be in Class A Uniform.
- Class B/Pack T-shirts & tennis shoes should be worn for events.
- No spiked shoes of any kind will be allowed for any event. Automatic disqualification of individuals and/or teams will result.
- Parents/Den Leaders are responsible for the behavior of their children/Scouts.
- No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are allowed.
- No smoking per Jones County Public Schools regulations.
- **Bring water, sunscreen, & insect repellent!**

- **Designated Unit Representative (DUR)** – Each unit must provide a DUR – This is the only member of the unit allowed to bring questions regarding results, controversies, or similar issues to the Challenge Chair or any Event Coordinator. Any other person from a unit doing so may cause disqualification for their Scout and/or Unit. Each Event Coordinator will have the list of DURs.
- No one may enter the Tally Area except for Challenge Staff & Unit Representatives!
- **No Scout will be allowed to compete unless Release of Liability is signed.**
- No units will be able to register the day of the event.
- No substitutions after registration unless due to illness or injury. Approval must be made by Challenge Chair.

- **Scouts will be awarded for 1st – 5th place in events.**
- **1st – 5th Overall Awards for Pack and Troop will be awarded.**
- **Boy Scouts from different units will work events on April 21.**

CUB SCOUT FIELD EVENTS

SOFTBALL THROW

- 2 throws will be allowed. The longest throw will be counted. The official measurement will be made at the point where the ball first hits the ground. The ball must be thrown from behind the line.

STANDING LONG JUMP

- 2 jumps will be allowed. The longest jump will be counted. Any part of the body making contact with the ground closest to the starting point will be the official measurement. The jump must begin from behind the starting line.

SACK RACE

- Timed event in which Scout will pick up sack, pull over feet & legs, hold sack with both hands, & jump from starting line to a turn to return to the starting line.

THREE-LEGGED RACE

- Each pack will have 3 teams of 2 Scouts. Each team will have one leg tied together. Teams will start in relay formation. Each team will run ten yards to a turn & go back to the start tagging the next team. Race will end once each team has finished.

KNOT RELAY

- Each pack will have 1 team of 5 Scouts running from starting point to judge, tie specified knot, which will be approved by the judge, & run back to start tagging next Scout. Race will end once each team has finished.

TUG-OF-WAR

- Maximum of 5 Scouts. Gloves are allowed. Opposing teams pull rope until flag moves designating winner. Multiple rounds will be held to determine winner.

CUB SCOUT TRACK EVENTS

25 YARD DASH – LION, TIGER & WOLF SCOUTS

- Timed event in which Scout runs 25 yards.

50 YARD DASH – ALL CUB SCOUTS

- Timed event in which Scout runs 50 yards.

100 YARD DASH – BEAR & WEBELOS SCOUTS

- Timed event in which Scout runs 100 yards.

200 YARD RELAY

- Timed event in which 4 Scouts run 50 yards each passing a baton at designated marks. Dropped batons must be picked up by current runner.
