This is the information packet for the 2017 Webeloree. Contained in this packet is the information and forms to prepare your Webelos for the Webeloree. This is my seventh year working with the Webeloree and I am looking forward to another successful weekend. This year's Webeloree is the “Webelos 500”. All the events will be geared toward car racing.

The cost per Webelos is \$10
Leaders, parents, and scouts are \$10

The cost will be same regardless if you stay the whole weekend, one night, or just for the day. As the date gets closer you will be able to register online through the Council Website.

TEAM Events:

There will be no ‘advance notice’ on exactly what the Team Events are going to be. None of the Team Events will require any advance training or knowledge. Since 2008, the Webeloree has been aimed at Webelos working as teams, not at Webelos activity pins. If there is specific knowledge that the participants will need, they will be taught it at the station prior to the start of judging. Webeloree is a fun camping trip, not a “final exam”. **Exception:** there IS going to be the traditional ‘fire building’ event. Make sure all of your Webelos know Fire Safety!

The final list of Team Event sponsors will be announced online through the Council Website. <http://www.eccbsa.org/Event%20Flyers> . Just like previous years, all of the Patrol Events will be conducted (and completed) before lunchtime.

All Team Events will be 25 minutes (Webelos enter area, complete event, cleanup, and leave within 25 minutes) and 5 minutes for travel between stations. All Scout Teams move between stations simultaneously. All Morning Events start at 9am, conclude at Noon. All morning events are ‘divided patrol’ based. (All Webelos divided into equal size Patrols with no Pack affiliation)

All Team Events will be Boy Scout, Venturer, or Explorer conducted.

Pack Events:

Afternoon events will be Pack-based, Staff conducted. (Volunteers Welcomed!) Pack Events will be conducted throughout the day.

Uniform Inspection:

(Saturday Morning)

Conducted per official BSA Uniform Inspection Form 34283A. All scores will be averaged for the entire pack, using the number of Scouts on the Final Roster.

Dutch Oven Event:

(Saturday afternoon)

Participating Webelos Leaders and/or (Asst) Cubmasters will make a complete recipe in a Dutch Oven from scratch (ie: Apple Crisp apples = pre-peeled apples in a bag...not the entire mix of apples, brown sugar, oatmeal, etc. in a bag)

The theme for the Dutch oven cook off is "**chicken wings**". Make them hot or make them mild. Chicken wings have always been a favorite as a NASCAR tailgating meal.

If enough Boy Scouts, Venturers, or Explorers wish to compete I will open up a Youth Dutch oven cook off. Only youth members will be allowed to compete. The above rules also apply.

Campsite Inspection:

(Saturday afternoon)

Campsite to be inspected for neatness / cleanliness and organization (no set pattern, just that there IS a pattern) See the attached Campsite inspection form.

Webelos Pack Events:

The Webelos pack event is going to be Push Mobile racing. Be a three part event: 1) Looks 2) Off road course against the clock 3) Precision driving course. See information in the packet about the push mobile events.

Scored by anonymous judges on Crowd Appeal and Performance Skills.

The Order of the Arrow will provide both an Arrow of Light Ceremony and a Cross Over Ceremony for those Webelos who are crossing over or about to cross over. We need to be informed a head of time if an Arrow of Light Ceremony, Cross Over Ceremony, or both ceremonies will be needed in advance.

Push Mobile Events

Rules:

- All Webelos Cub Scouts either riding the pushmobile or pushing the pushmobile **MUST** wear helmet, knee pads, and elbow pads. If they are not wearing the helmet and pads they **Will NOT** be allowed to take part in the event. Bring several pairs of pads and helmets because more than Webelos Cub Scouts will push during an event. Protective gear will NOT be provided so each Pack needs to bring their own.
- Pictures must be provided showing that the Webelos Cub Scouts worked on putting the push mobile together.
- Will allow up to 24 inch (rim) inflatable wheels to be used on the push mobile.
- Seat belts must clip together. No tie or slip through belts allowed.
- Side rails around the seat are required to help keep Webelos Cub Scouts in the seat.
- Push bar must be firmly attached to the back of the push mobile.
- The push mobile can only be powered by being pushed by a Webelos Cub Scout.
- Instructions on making the push mobile are provided in this packet. It is a guide and you can personalize it as long as the safety features are included.

Competition:

Round 1: Looks: Each push mobile will be judge on workmanship and design. A panel of judges will decide the winner

Round 2: Off Road Course: There will be an off road course set up at Camp Charles. The Webelos will push the mobile along the course racing against the clock.

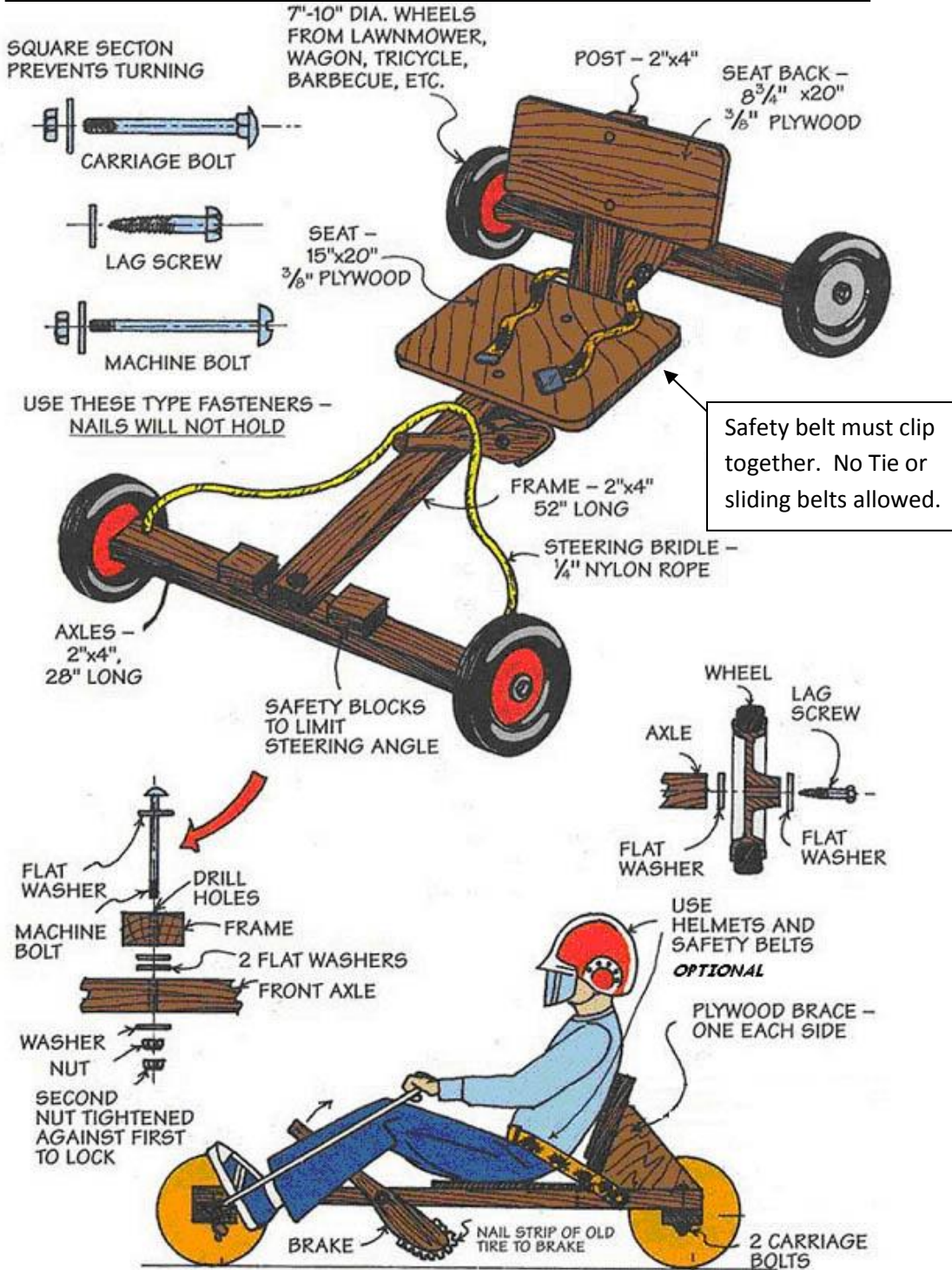
Round 3: Precision course: There will be a precision course set up where the Webelos will have to turn and steer their push mobile through or around obstacles.

BOY SCOUTS, VENTURERS, AND EXPLORERS ONLY:

Can build a push mobile and compete in competition between troops, crews, posts or intra-unit.

Must attach side rails to keep youth in the vehicle!

Uniform Inspection.

Conduct the uniform inspection with common sense; the basic rule is neatness.

General Appearance. Allow 4 points for each:

20 pts.

- Good posture
- Clean face and hands
- Combed hair
- Neatly dressed
- Clean fingernails

Headgear. Webelos cap. Webelos activity badges are worn on the plaid front panel of the Webelos cap or on the optional Webelos colors, if selected by the pack.

5 pts.

Notes _____

Shirt. Webelos Scouts have the option of wearing either the long- or short-sleeve navy blue shirt and navy blue shorts or pants OR the long- or short-sleeve tan shirt with the official convertible Boy Scout pants or official shorts or pants. The blue shoulder loops are worn on epaulets regardless of the uniform color.

15 pts.

Notes _____

Neckwear. Triangular, plaid neckerchief secured by the Webelos rank slide.

5 pts.

Notes _____

Pants/Shorts. Webelos Scouts may wear either the official navy blue pants or shorts (with the navy blue shirt), or the official convertible Boy Scout pants (with the tan shirt), or the official Boy Scout pants or shorts (with the tan shirt).

15 pts.

Notes _____

Belt. Official navy blue web belt cut to proper length with the Webelos insignia on the buckle. Cub Scout belt loops are worn only on the navy blue belt. Webelos Scouts wearing the optional tan uniform wear the navy blue belt and Webelos buckle.

5 pts.

Notes _____

Socks. The official navy blue socks (with gold tops) are worn with the navy blue uniform. The official socks are worn with the official Boy Scout uniform.

5 pts.

Shoes. Neat and clean.

5 pts.

Notes _____

Insignia.* Correct placement: left pocket, 5 points; right pocket, 5 points; left sleeve, 5 points; right sleeve, 5 points.
