The veterans will give us a brief update on what to do, have us sign up for cemeteries, and send us on our way.

**WHO** - All Scouts are welcome and encouraged to attend. Bring water bottles or canteens to drink as we work. Wear full Scout uniforms, and be prepared for weather conditions. As you go about your duty, have fun, but remember that a Scout is Reverent.
